BFSO Named Awards

Faculty and staff are invited to submit nominations for the Myron Burney Service Award (MBSA), the Mark Dawkins Leadership Award (MDLA) and the Melanie A. Burden Community Award (MABCA). These awards are presented in honor of three BFSO Presidents who worked tirelessly to advance the efforts of BFSO and improve the Black experience on UGA's campus. MBSA, MDLA and MABCA require nomination(s) by a UGA faculty or staff member. The nominee is NOT required to submit an application. Nominators are asked to complete the 2024 BFSO Nomination Submission form to submit their UGA affiliation & contact information, the nominated student's contact information, and a brief summary of that student's qualifications for the award by Friday, September 6th at 5pm.

Myron Burney Service Award (MBSA)

• Recognizes a current UGA student with a minimum 3.0 GPA who has demonstrated outstanding community service in the Black community both on and off campus.

Mark Dawkins Leadership Award (MDLA)

Recognizes a current UGA student with a minimum 3.0 GPA. The student must also have
at least one year of leadership experience on the Executive Board of a UGA student
organization whose primary purpose is to meet the academic and social needs of Black
students.

Melanie A. Burden Community Award (MABCA)

 Recognizes a current UGA student with a minimum 3.0 GPA who has demonstrated outstanding commitment in community service, leadership and mentorship with young girls or young women.

The scholarship sub- committee reserves the right to move an otherwise qualified candidate to another award for a BFSO Scholarship. Recipients of awards will be notified by Friday, September 13th.

All scholarships and awards will be presented at the Annual Founders Scholarship Luncheon on Monday, September 30, 2024, 11:30 am – 1 pm Mahler Hall of the Georgia Center for Continuing Education & Hotel. Recipients must be present to accept scholarship and awards.
